

Grzegorz Dubin (Head of the Protein Crystallography Research Group at Malopolska Centre of Biotechnology, Jagiellonian University, Krakow, Poland)

Grzegorz Dubin did his PhD at the Jagiellonian University in Krakow, Poland (prof. J. Potempa) and Max-Planck Institute for Biochemistry in Martinsried, Germany (prof. T. Holak) where he began his adventure with protein crystallography. Back in Poland he participated in establishing the Malopolska Centre of Biotechnology JU where he created an independent crystallography research group which he leads since 2012, currently as an Associate Professor. Early works included characterization of virulence factors of a dangerous human pathogen *Staphylococcus aureus*. Currently his laboratory is involved in structural and functional characterization of promising therapeutic targets in cancer and neglected tropical diseases. He has co-authored 80 scientific articles and leads a group of 12 Postdocs and PhDs. Along basic research, he was involved in R&D and translational activities, supporting the expansion of a biotechnology company BioCentrum Ltd. Later he organized Preparatis Ltd. where he held the CEO position of between 2014-2018.
